The workshop explores schedule management in all its facets. It provides useful information and guidance on schedule submissions in ENTSO-E Scheduling System (ESS) format, along with hands-on exercises on schedule creation and correction.

The participation fee is approx. 600€ per person. There is an additional charge of 100€ per person for the optional “Kölsche Networking” event.
